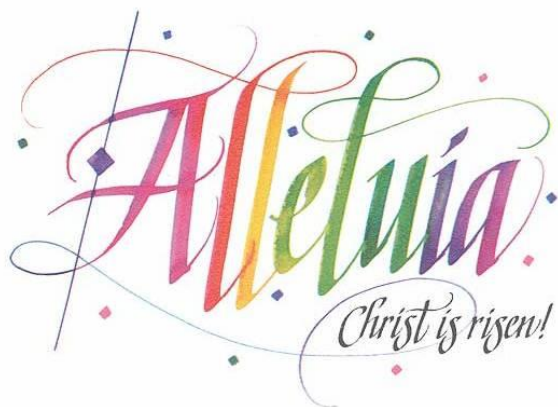

## Open House Reception

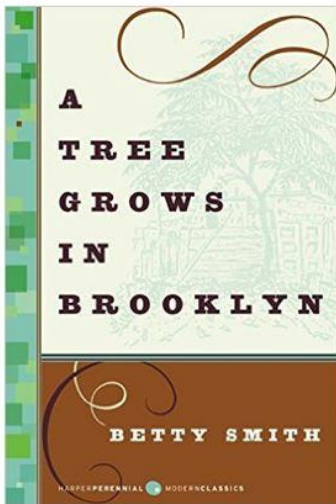
You are invited to an Open House Reception to honor Linda Olsen, Executive Director of We Care In the Name of Christ.
