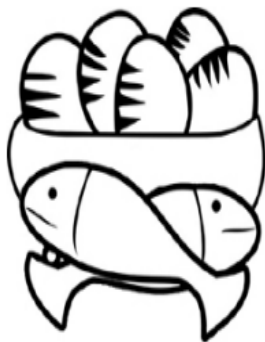
Decoration Committee
