Love, Healing, and Development with Dr. Anne Halley

Anne Halley, DMin, is an Adjunct Instructor in Doctor of Ministry at Ashland Theological Seminary. She is an expert on child development and the brain. Anne is a clinician, but not clinical, more grandmotherly. Her teaching style is that of sharing stories.

It is important that each of us knows our story developmentally. We are to listen for the voice of the shepherd. Jesus said, "I am the Good Shepherd. I know each of My sheep by name and they know Me by the sound of My voice." In our world there are so many competing voices and it is hard to listen for the voice of our Shepherd. What would it mean to hear His voice? What would that feel like? We were created neurologically, physically, emotionally and spiritually to respond to God. How we respond to God depends on our life story. Our experience of secure attachment in childhood sets the foundation for knowing ourselves, others and God. God created us with core longings to know unconditional love, security, understanding, purpose and significance and most of all that we belong. What does it mean to feel these core longings? What did we miss? We all missed something. Having our core longings met is essential to our well being. We need a spiritual intervention, a full experience of God's love and attachment to us for healing to occur. As an expert in neurobiology and child development Anne Halley will teach us about how the brain, wired in childhood, can create new neural pathways through God's healing and love.

Alpha Course Resumes Wednesday, March 8th




