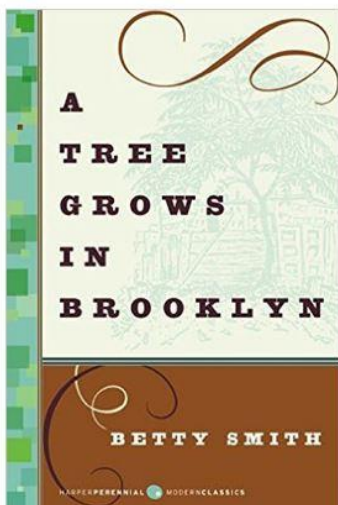

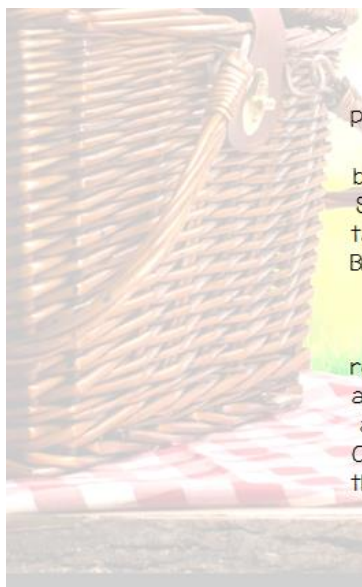
## Women's Summer Book Club
