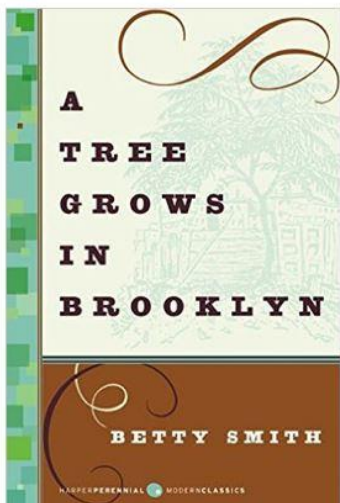

Calling all confirmands: If you are hoping to be confirmed upon the Bishop's next visit please speak with Fr. Rick about preparation classes this summer.



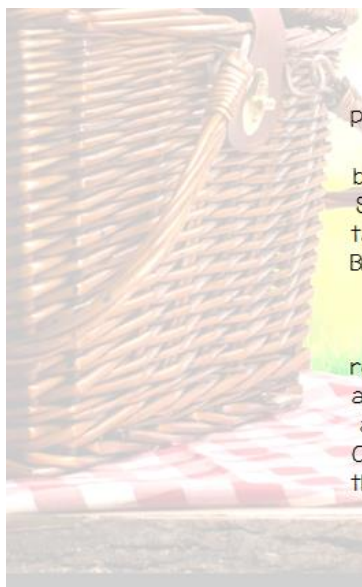
Women's Summer Book Club
