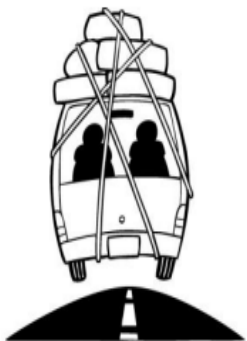
Decoration Committee
