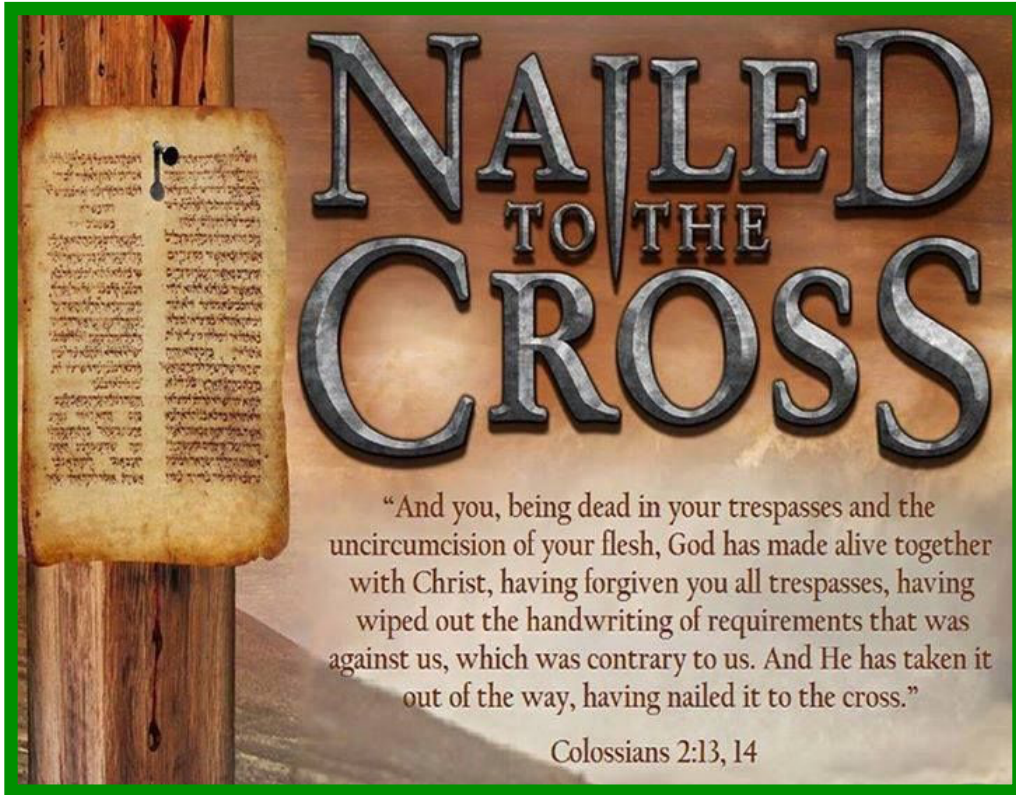

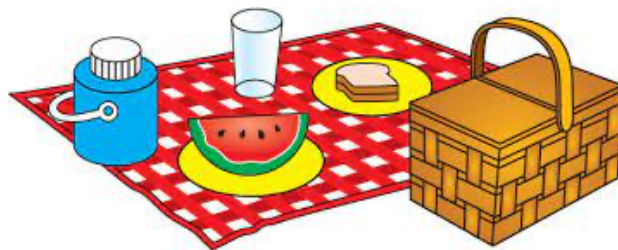
Thursday, July 28, 10am-4pm: Fr. Rob's office hours. Call for an appointment at (616) 821-7474.
